

CODE OF CONDUCT

1. Photo ID Card: Identity Verification

- All students are required to wear their photo ID cards visibly at all times within the college premises.

2. Uniform Guidelines

- On Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday, students must wear complete uniforms.
- On Wednesday, college T-shirts and formal trousers must be worn.

- All instances of sexual harassment, Be it verbal, written, or physical, will be vigorously addressed according to Indian legal framework.

12. Forgery or Record Alteration

- Forgery, tampering, or alteration of college records, documents, or certificates is strictly prohibited.

- Unauthorised access to computer systems, networks, or data is a violation of the college's code of conduct.
